WHO ARE WE?

Wilton PTA Council is the umbrella organization encompassing all of Wilton's PTAs and PTSA units. Council's purpose is to unify and strengthen the individual units and enhance communication and cooperation among them. As a separate organization, the Council, through programming, seeks to strengthen the communication between our parents, teachers and students and to promote the purposes of National PTA. In addition, Council provides a bi-annual Gifts & Grants Program which assists the educators in the Wilton Public Schools provide our children with an excellent education.

OUR FUNDING GUIDELINES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

1. Council funds are to be used to enrich and develop the normal programs provided by the school district and/or develop new initiatives in education.
2. Council does not fund projects or equipment that should be included in the Board of Education Budget.
3. Council will attempt to distribute funding among all age levels and schools within the district.
4. If Council funds are to be used to benefit a small group, the Council will consider how the project benefits the larger school community.
5. Council will consider whether long-standing programs have become an integral part of the curriculum and should be funded by the school district.
6. Money cannot be disbursed without a purchase order, paid receipt, invoice or cancelled check. All items purchased with PTA Council grant monies become the property of the Wilton Public Schools
